



BDEAC IN FIVE KEY WORDS

The Central African States Development Bank « Banque de Développement des États de l'Afrique Centrale », known under the French acronym BDEAC, is the Development Financing Institution of the Economic and Monetary Community of Central Africa (CEMAC), comprising Cameroon, Central African Republic, Congo, Gabon, Equatorial Guinea and Chad.

Five key words (in French) may summarize BDEAC's general features as follows:

Banque (Bank)

Although the word « bank » usually refers to a place where an account holder can deposit or withdraw money, or a place where currency is issued, BDEAC is neither a retail bank nor a central bank. As a Financial Institution, its role is to support and provide loans for development projects in both private and public sectors.

Développement (Development)

BDEAC's mission revolves around one important word: « Development ».

As a matter of fact, the Institution focuses its financing on projects with the highest economic and social added value. Priority is also given to major government infrastructure projects, critical contributors to sustainable growth.

Etats (Member States)

BDEAC qualifies as an International Institution, considering its global membership.

But its vision is grounded in its statutory role as CEMAC's Development Bank, with a geographical scope of operations including Cameroon, Central African Republic, Congo, Gabon, Equatorial Guinea and Chad.

Afrique (Africa)

Most confident in Africa's potential and economic outlook, BDEAC has devised strategies to tap locally and regionally available resources. This translates into specific financial instruments aimed at mobilising countries' financial surpluses to support development projects.

Centrale (Central)

With CEMAC's sustainable growth as its overarching goal, BDEAC strives to become a central platform that federates resources for the Subregion's economic development. Its experience, values, as well as its network of local and international partners are a few arguments in support of that ambition.
